Submitting your poster abstract - Deadline extended to Tuesday 21 April 2009

Please email to hopper09comp@dcs.qmul.ac.uk by Tuesday 21 April 2009, a Word document with the following information in the order shown:

1. Title of Poster
2. Your name, Academic status [PhD or Postdoctoral]
3. Institution and affiliation(s)
4. Email address
5. An abstract of your research topic, no more than 200 words in length

This information should be in text font Arial, size 11 and must fit on one side A4.

Posters may cover any research topic within the field of computer science and/or interdisciplinary studies connected to computer science. Accepted abstracts will be included in the conference proceedings pack and distributed to delegates attending the Colloquium.

Preparing your poster

1. Poster size can be either: A1 (594x 841mm) or A0 (841x1189mm)
2. Posters can be either portrait or landscape
3. Your poster title, name, institution and affiliation(s) must be on the poster
4. Entrants should bring their completed posters with them on the day of the Colloquium where a display area will be made available
5. Posters will be wall-mounted and Blu-Tack will be available at the colloquium

An effective poster will:

1. Convey your message clearly
2. Have immediate visual impact
3. Get people talking
4. Encourage people to contact you for further information
